



TREKKING TO NATURAL MONUMENT

EL MORADO

The Natural Monument El Morado is located just 93 Km far from de Santiago, in Andes Mountains, surrounded by high peaks like El Morado (5060m) and the volcano San José (5870m).

This trekking takes around 5 hours, in a low difficulty level, with well defined trails and altitud not over 1.800m. It's not necessary previous experience and is able for all ages.

On the way we will find natural souches of carbonated water (Panimávidas), wich can be drank. Endemic wildlife can be seen, like the Cometocino, bird that friendly follow people looking for some food left on the way, besides the big condor and other species.

The trail ends in Morales Lagoon, crettaed by the melting of the glaciár hanging over it, habitat of Juarjual duck. With an amazing view to El Morado mountain, this is the perfect place for recovering energy and taking pictures before start the way back.

Meeting: Parque Bustamante (Metro Baquedano)

Bring: Water, snack, comfortable clothes and shoes for walking, jacket, sunscreen, sunglasses.

Includes: Transfer, full time guide

Not included: Entrance to the Park (\$1.500 p/p)
