



VALLE DE COLINA HOT-SPRINGS

Embedded in the Cajón del Maipo, about 140km from Santiago and approximate 2.550m.o.s.l. are the natural hot-springs Valle de Colina. These 8 pools that sprout at the base of San José Volcano vary between 25 and 60°C and from its waters is possible to observe the imposing Andes Mountains, with peaks exceeding 6.000m.o.s.l.

We leave Santiago at noon, making a stop to savor the typical food at San Jose de Maipo. After lunch, we keep our travel seeing summits, glaciers and valleys of Maipo.

The estimated arrival at Colina is at 4pm, when a medium level trek can be made until a belvedere of San José Volcano, Marmolejo Hill and Engorda Valley. After the hike starts the hot-springs bathing, watching the sunset and stars coming, in the company of a good chilean wine.

At 22h we leave to return to Santiago.

Bring: water, sunscreen, sunglasses, comfortable clothing and walking shoes, bathing suit, towel, warm clothes for the night.

Includes: transfer, full time guide, entrance to the Valle de Colina, snack in the pools (½ bottle of wine p / p, sandwiches, nuts, cheese and fruit)

Not included: lunch
